IFES DOMINICAN STUDENTS AND OUR STAFF TEAM DISCUSS THE SUMMER MISSION STRATEGY.

Fully Funded for 2012!

During the month of November, my support reached the 100% mark for the 2012 calendar year! Once again, we are so grateful for your sacrificial giving. It is a daily reminder of God's love for us and provision through His Church. Jackie and I feel blessed that the fund raising process has rekindled old relationships and developed new ones around this mission. I will resume fundraising for the 2013 calendar year in May.

Another highlight this month **was forming a strategic partnership** with IV's international organization, IFES (International Fellowship of Evangelical Students) in the Dominican Republic for the summer of 2012. IV USA is just one member of the IFES that has student ministries in over one hundred and fifty countries. IFES in the Dominican Republic consists of five full-time staff, and has over one hundred student members in four cities. The University we will work on in the summer has 130,000 students!

Dominican Republic Vision Trip

The staff team for the 2012 summer mission went to Santo Domingo to **participate in the IFES meetings from November 7th to the 11th**. It was my responsibility to set up the trip and lead our partnership effort with the IFES there. Our meetings resulted in a commitment to begin our partnership this coming June. We will bring twelve students from New England, and the Dominican IFES will have eight students and one staff. The IFES staff expressed that they have **desired a US partnership for years**, and it appears the Holy Spirit is now opening the doors.

The mission will begin in June with a week long campus ministry effort in Santo Domingo. We will reach out to Haitian students, who many Dominican ministries overlook due to years of ethnic tension and pain. The IFES movement is burdened by the relationship between Haitians' and Dominicans' and **believes God is calling them to be a part of the healing process in light of Ephesians 2:16**. We will then spend one week in a poor Haitian community doing service ministry, to be followed up with another week and a half of campus ministry in Santo Domingo.

Student Ownership at UNH

I continue to be **impressed with the UNH leadership team taking responsibility for the ministry**. The team includes Amy (prayer), Jeff (leadership development), Phil (community), Briana (service), Dave (small groups), Chelsea (evangelism), and Lindsey (large group). Please pray that they would continue to empower their peers and reach out to non-believers through their area of responsibility.
